

We sent email announcements and mailings to 651 alumni, inviting them to complete the online survey or mail a hard copy of the survey to us. **A total of 29%, or 190 alumni, completed the survey**. This response rate is higher than the 23% response rate achieved for the 2012 alumni survey (alumni surveys typically draw a response rate between 10% and 20%, according to national averages).

Employment Statistics


- 93.62% of alumni surveyed are employed

Relevant to Field of Study


- Of alumni employed 77.27% said that their job is directly or somewhat related to their field of study

Length of Time to Find Employment


- 1-3 months **26.70%**





- 63.98% did not intern in their field




Graduate School
