Course Alternatives for Public Administration and Organizational Leadership Students

Prior Learning Assessment / Credit for Professional Certifications

For: Applying / transfer students

After appropriate transfer credits from other colleges and universities, specifically reviewed and designated professional certifications can be used for either general electives or course-to-course equivalencies. The reviewed professional certifications are listed in the "Credit and Transfer Course Correlation" document.

Credit coursework from other colleges and universities is considered for transfer first, then Prior Learning Assessment.

ACE Recommended Coursework

For: Applying / transfer students and enrolled students with prior approval

Public safety personnel are eligible to attend federal training schools and academies, primarily the National Fire Academy (NFA) and the Emergency Management Institutes (EMI). Most of those courses carry ACE credit recommendations and are outlined in the Correlation document. These can be used for credits as described in the Prior Learning Assessment section, above, or for current students attending NFA courses with specific course correlations, as courses taken at another institution.

Independent Study

For: Enrolled students

Independent study courses are conducted one-on-one between the student and instructor and follow all of the coursework typical for a traditional on-ground or online course.

Experiential Learning

For: Enrolled students

Experiential learning is for students who have current workplace (paid or volunteer) activities that parallel existing coursework in PADM or LEAD courses and can provide documentation of how that experience would meet or exceed the objectives of the course. Special topic courses may also be considered.

Professional Certifications: Emergency Medical Services (EMS)

General Information: Without approval of the PADM program coordinator, the certification must be current (active, not expired or revoked) and issued by a US state/territory or the National Registry of EMTs (NREMT). The definitions of certification levels are determined by the USDOT National Standard Training Curricula for EMS, though the titles of certifications may vary from state to state. Certificates other than those issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Health or the NREMT, including those issued by the US Military may need to be translated. It is recommended that the credentials be verified by methods other than a certificate provided by the student. This may include a direct request for official documentation from the certifying agency.
