## TRANSFER PARTNERSHIP

### Receive Advanced Standing

Under a formal transfer agreement, BCCC students who have completed the following associates degrees within specified disciplines may continue at Point Park as advanced standing students with junior status: *Associate Degree in Arts, Associate Degree in Science, and Associate Degree in Applied Science.*

### The associate degree must demonstrate:

- 30 credits in general education course work - including English, computer science, math, social sciences, human sciences, natural science, speech and art
- 18 credits of major-related content
- An earned grade of C- or better in courses
