TRANSFER PARTNERSHIP

Receive Advanced Standing

Under a formal transfer agreement, WCCC students who have completed the following associates degrees within specified disciplines may continue at Point Park as advanced standing students with junior status: *Associate Degree in Arts* and *Associate Degree in Science*.

The associate degree must demonstrate:

- 30 credits in general education content
- 18 credits of major-related content
- An earned grade of C- or better in courses
